ANSWER ALL OF THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS

1. Describe one of your own personal interviews with a homeless individual for your *Street Roots* story.
 - First: Give the person's name, and describe how you found him/her. Talk about a few of the questions you asked, and what you ended up talking about the most. Describe how the interview began and ended, and when it was over, what about the interview/interviewee impacted you the most.
 - Second: How much of the information from the interview will be ending up in the final version of the story? Why?
2. If you had an insightful or emotional moment either photographing or reporting your *Street Roots* story over the last few weeks, what was it – and when was it? -- and why do you think it impacted you the way it did? If you didn't have an insightful or emotional moment, reflect on the reasons why.
2. What specifically did you like the most about working in a team? What specifically did you like the least?

There are no correct or incorrect answers. Thoughtful, articulate reflection and thorough explanation will be the basis for evaluation of the essay.
